

ORDINANCE 1161

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X OF
“REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF
THE BOROUGH OF DEAL, 1982”

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF DEAL HEREBY
ORDAIN:

Section 1. That Chapter X of the “Revised General Ordinance of the Borough
of Deal, 1982 be and it hereby is amended in the following particulars:

Section 2.

Subsection 10-36 A **Handicap Parking in Municipal Parking Lots and
Board of Education Property** is amended to read as follows:

Subsection 10-36 A 2(a)4 **Permit Parking** is amended to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle at the below described location unless said
vehicle shall have a valid permit displayed during the open season. In order
to be properly displayed, a parking permit must be hung from the rearview
mirror facing forward or should be placed face-up on the dashboard to the left
of the steering wheel. Make sure no other paper or garbage is covering up
the placard. A parking permit shall only be valid if the bathhouse lessee to
whom it has been issued has paid all charges made in connection with the
lessee’s bathhouse.

Subsection 10-36 A 3(a)4 **Permit Parking** is amended to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle at the below described location unless said
vehicle shall have a valid permit displayed during the open season. In order

to be properly displayed, a parking permit must be hung from the rearview mirror facing forward or should be placed face-up on the dashboard to the left of the steering wheel. Make sure no other paper or garbage is covering up the placard. A parking permit shall only be valid if the bathhouse lessee to whom it has been issued has paid all charges made in connection with the lessee's bathhouse.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
